This half day field trip will be offered to 2nd and 3rd grade students. Available on a first come, first serve basis. **Must pre-register by Feb. 1st.**

The Life on the Farm program will be an educational look at the different species of animals that are raised on a farm. Students will be able to touch animals and learn about methods of caring for them. They will also learn about the by-products of animals.

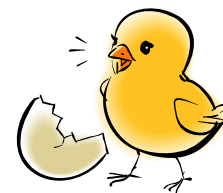


Embryology

This project can be scheduled January through March, depending on the availability of fertile eggs. Students will take the responsibilities of caring for the eggs during the twenty-one day incubation period and the baby chicks after they have hatched.

Resources for this project are:

- I. Supportive information
- II. Incubator
- III. Staff can make 2 or 4 visits.
- IV. One dozen fertile eggs
- V. Projector provided, if available, for candling 1st and 2nd week



Note: This is a time-consuming project. You must be willing to turn the eggs three times a day, keep water in the incubator, monitor the temperature, candle, and clean the incubator thoroughly after the hatch.

Fee is \$10.00 per class for two visits or \$18.00 for 4 visits (includes candling).
